### **Children Dental Services**

S.M.I.L.E. Plus Children's Dental Program is now accepting new patients.

The S.M.I.L.E. plus program was introduced in Winnipeg over 20 years ago to provide dental services for children. This Public Health Service is provided by the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority in partnership with the University of Manitoba, Faculty of Dentistry.

We provide low cost dental services to children in Winnipeg. We have a Pediatric Dental Specialist and dental team available Monday to Friday to provide oral health care for your child.

### Who?

- Any children under 18 years of age.
- Any child whose parents meet our income requirements.
- Any family who has Social Assistance or FNIHB coverage for their child(ren).
- We do not accept families who have private dental insurance coverage for their children.

#### How?

- By appoinement only

### Where?

- The Machray School Dental Clinic
- 320 Mountain Avenue 940-2090

### Cost?

- Appointments are a minimum of \$30.00 per visit
- As much dental work as possible is done at each appointment.

As a clinic patient, your child will be called for regular check-ups every 6 months and will be offered additional care as needed as long as they continue to meet eligibility requirements.

Our children's oral health team will provide your child with quality dental care.

January 27<sup>th</sup> is "Family Literacy Day" --- a day created by ABC Canada Literacy Foundation in 1999 to promote the importance of reading and learning together as a family. Ideas to help you practice family literacy in your home and community include:

- Have family time to read with your child
- Organize a children's book club in your neighbourhood
- Pick one night a week to visit your neighbourhood library
- Keep teens reading by giving them books, newspaper articles and magazines about things that interest them --- music, movies, TV and computers
- Zap off the TV and pick up a book instead
- Remember that children learn by example you are the key to improving your child's reading ability by placing a high priority on reading in your home
- Share a funny/interesting part of what you're reading and see what happens... you'll probably find someone shares back

Morning class times are from 8:50 am to 11:20 am and our afternoon class times are from 12:45 pm to 3:15 pm. Our programs run from September to June. Please note that subsidies are available.

Our dedicated teachers and well equipped classrooms provide quality preschool education in a safe, fun, spacious, clean, and stimulating atmosphere. All teachers have a minimum of Early Childhood Educator II accreditation. Our Director is an Early Childhood Educator III, with a Bachelor of Education Degree. Children participate in free play, printing practice, crafts, music and movement, learning circles, and story time. A large school gymnasium is available which enhances our physical education program. Each child brings their own healthy snack for snack time. Please note that we are a nut free facility.
